Baltimore, MD (February 24, 2023) –On behalf of the legal team, and all those we represent in this matter, we believe this publicly-released memorandum of law and order of the court is an immensely important step on the path to accountability and justice for survivors preyed upon over decades within the Archdiocese of Baltimore. Its release is particularly timely in the aftermath of yesterday’s profoundly powerful Maryland state Senate Committee hearing on the proposed Child Victims Act; during that hearing numerous survivors (including those preyed upon as children by clergy of the Archdiocese of Baltimore) courageously shared their horrifying accounts of child sexual abuse. We look forward to vigorously pursuing justice for our clients and all Maryland survivors.
